Repeater-Builder's notes on getting (and staying) in the bootloader mode of an STM32-DVM board

Pi-Star has changed the way it runs MMDVMHost. It *REALLY* wants to start it up. This should stop it in its tracks:

- 1. Boot Pi-Star
- 2. login (Default -> usr: pi-star pass: raspberry)
- 3. Issue the following commands:
 - ...:~\$ sudo -s
 - ...:~\$ rpi-rw
 - ...:~\$ cd /etc
 - ...:~\$ mv mmdvmhost mmdvmhost.save
 - ...:~\$ poweroff
- 4. put board in bootloader (short JP1 pins)
- 5. power on Rasperry Pi
- get utilities and source code / Program DVM board
 (See: https://github.com/N4IRS/MMDVM-Install/tree/master/STM32-DVM)
- 7. Issue the following commands:
 - ... :~\$ rpi-rw
 - ... :~\$ cd /etc
 - ... :~\$ mv mmdvmhost.save mmdvmhost
 - ... :~\$ poweroff
- 8. remove jumper
- 9. power on Rasperry Pi The board should boot normally
