Investigation has revealed evidence of a "whisker type" growth within the castings of the above mentioned Image and Injection Filters used on the MSF product.

This growth slowly degrades the receiver sensitivity to a point where it becomes necessary to retune the filter to restore proper receiver performance. In some instances the filter cannot be retuned to the customers' frequency.

If degradation of receiver sensitivity has occured due to the above mentioned "whisker growth" problem, it is recommended that a new filter be obtained from the Schaumburg Factory. The type of plating being used currently has been revised and eliminates the "whisker growth" problem. All stations shipping from APRIL,1993 contain the new filters.

NOTE: NOT ALL FILTERS WILL EXPERIENCE THIS PROBLEM! CLEANING OF THE FILTERS THAT EXPERIENCE THE WHISKER GROWTH PROBLEM, IS ONLY A TEMPORARY RESOLUTION. THE WHISKERS WILL CONTINUE TO REAPPEAR.
